Math:

K-Algebra 2

English:

K-8th grade, English Learners (1-2), English Literature

Long-Term Projects

Since last month, we have made progress on our various active long-term projects (besides the Tutoring Program). Here are some updates:

NPO Research and Database Project:

Our club has done research on Non-Profit Organizations regarding certain topics including Engineering, Business, etc. Doing research allows our club to find possible sponsor-ships and partnerships along with more volunteer opportunities for our members.

Book Bank:

After our successful book drive project, we ended up with hundreds more left-over books than we anticipated. The book bank team has been researching possible organizations to work with to distribute these leftover books, as well as planning more collection projects for the future.

Environmental Research:

We have various different environmentally-related projects planned out. Because of the pandemic, many programs are closed, but we plan to do more environmental projects in the near future.

Destination Imagination:

Since the DI Regional Tournament, our club has mentored two different teams. Now that the State Tournament is over, we plan on expanding this project to more than just mentoring.

World Language:

French, Mandarin Chinese, Spanish

Science:

K-8th grade, Biology, Chemistry, Bio-Med

Speech:

Public Speaking, Speech and Debate, Competitive Debate

Miscellaneous:

History, Golf, 3-D Design and Modeling, Saxophone.

Math, English, Science, History, World Language, Speech, and more! (K-8th grade)

So far, we have more than ten different tutors that will contribute to this program. These tutoring classes should take place at scheduled intervals throughout the week. This program will not only include general homework help sessions, but also specific, planned curriculums (listed above).
