Treasurer - 1 person	 Oversees fundraising Collaborates with adult board to monitor club funds Budget planning and record keeping Reports to rest of the club board regarding funds

Publicity Officer - 2 people

Regional Director - 1 per city

- In charge of advertising and our club's social media presence
- Helps with expanding our club's reach
- Manages connections with other organizations and people
- Expands club into respective regions
 - Looks for volunteer opportunities within respective regions
 - Communicates with rest of club board to situate new members
- Incorporates club into schools


General Requirements to Run

- Applicants must declare all verified Breaking BEARriers volunteer hours and share their form
- Attended at least two public meetings since August 2021
- Must have participated in at least one project
- Minimum of 10 Breaking BEARriers Volunteer Hours
 - 25 for Co-President
 - 15 for Vice President
